For the latest stable kernel source please use Linus's git tree or the kernel.org kernels directly. Kernel updates relevant to SH are placed in a special pull-tree for merging, however this tree is only updated when preparing an upstream merge and generally should not be used. Changes are pulled into Andrew Morton's -mm tree automatically, so those that are looking to try out more experimental code are recommended to use that instead.
